



Annual Report of NSS 2024-25



Rajkiya Kanya Mahavidyalaya, Shimla (Session 2024-25)

The NSS units of Rajkiya Kanya Mahavidyalaya (RKMV), Shimla, actively participated in various social and environmental initiatives throughout the academic session 2024-25. The details of the activities conducted are as follows:

1. One-Day Cleanliness Camp (10th August 2024)

Venue: College Administrative Block, College Open Stage, College Ground, Science Block, New Block, and College Parking

Description: The NSS volunteers undertook a comprehensive cleanliness drive, sweeping and cleaning the entire college premises. 
Afternoon Session:


Conclusion




