


Red Ribbon Club Activities - RKMV Shimla

International Youth Day Marathon -RED RUN (11/08/2024)

International Youth Day was organized by Himachal Pradesh AIDS Control Society. The programme was held at Peterhoff Shimla. 65 volunteers of RKMV Shimla participated in Youth Day Awareness programme on HIV and AIDS. The students also participated in tile painting event. Students were sensitized to promote awareness about HIV/AIDS, reduce stigma and discrimination, and encourage other students to take an active role in preventing the spread of disease.


A Training Programme (28/11/2024)



World AIDS Day (01/12/2024)
