


1. Your negotiation letter dated 01.09.2021 shall form part and parcel of the contract agreement.

- 3). You will have to produce Income-Tax-clearance certificate for the last year from the Income tax Officer, before any payment is made to you for this work.
- 4). The material used for the execution of the work should be of PWD specification and the same must be got checked from the Engineer-In-charge. In addition to above you will have to produce a certificate duly issued along with stamp from the manufacturers of their accredited authorized dealer (attach also their attested dealership certificate) showing the make/Model and Code No. of the Electrical fitting/fixtures/appliances and non-scheduled items what so ever given in the schedule of quantity against the above cited subject work. Please ensure that the certificate in question should be attached with the bill for payment positively.
- 5). You will have to submit the detailed key diagram in duplicate showing clearly switches/Main/Sub-mains etc. along with the points of distribution of circuits.
- 6). Please note that no payment shall be made to you for this work until and unless you sign the contract agreement, which is ready for your signature in this office.
- 7) Hapzred below items will have to be executed first.
- 8) Wiring be done in colour scheme of cables red, yellow and blue in three phase wiring with black as neutral and green earth. For single phase wiring any of the three colours one be used as phase, black as neutral and green as earth including main sub

Kindly refer to subject noted above; it is intimated that inspection of site for installation of Grid connected Roof Top Solar Power Plant at RKMV Left out buildings is carried out by Himurja officials on dated 19/02/2025 and accordingly 1 No. 20 Kw Grid Solar Plant has been proposed in Administrative & C Block South Facing Roof Top in RKMV Shimla as per site feasibility & connected load.

Brief Technical Descriptions of proposed 20 Kw Solar Plant is as under:

- Inverter:** Grid Tied Three Phase Inverter will be provided conforming BIS/IEC Standards. Inverter will be MPPT Integrated and will capable of withstanding 10% overload.
- Solar Modules/ Panels:** 550 Watt Mono Perc Solar Panel will be provided. Solar Modules will use domestic manufactured cell and will conform IEC Standards.
- Module Mounting Structure:** Hot Dip Galvanized or Aluminum Structure will be used. All bolts nuts & fasteners will be of SS 304 OR Hot Dip Galvanized Iron.
- Cables:** Cables used will be flexible and size will be selected so that losses can be less than 2%. Operating Temperature is from -10 Degree Centigrade to 80 Degree Centigrade and voltage rating 660 volt /1000 Volt.
- Metering:** Grid Connectivity including providing DISCOM Tested Net Meter & Solar Meter will be overlooked by Himurja empanelled vendor.
- Protection:** Necessary Surge, Earthing & Lightning Protection will be provided. Earthing resistance will be assured to be less than 5 Ohm.
- Warranty:** Solar Plant will be in warranty for 3 Years from Date of Installation.

**Saving Analysis on Installation of 20 Kw Grid Connected Solar Power Plant :-**

- Total Energy Generated Per Day from 20 Kw Grid Solar Plant = 89 Units
- Energy Generated Per Month = 2400 Units
- Energy Generation Considering 300 Sunny Days in a year = 24000 Units
- Saving Per Year at current Energy Tariff= 6.16x24000= ₹1,47,840/-
- Total Time taken to cover initial investment of ₹8,16,690/- = Five Years Six Months

It is intimated that once Himurja receives estimated amount; Supply order is placed to empanelled firm and work will be completed within 3 Months from date of award.

# Solid Waste Segregation and Management

The institution adopts a proactive and systematic approach to solid waste segregation and management, ensuring that all waste generated on campus is treated responsibly through source segregation into biodegradable and non-biodegradable categories.

## Management of Biodegradable Waste



Compost pits have been established in the college and hostel premises to ensure scientific disposal of biodegradable waste. These pits generate nutrient-rich manure, which is used to maintain the campus greenery. Surplus manure is sold, contributing to sustainable practices and generating modest revenue.

**Composting of Biodegradable Waste:** Under a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the EarthJust NGO, the department has introduced a composting project to process biodegradable waste generated by the college canteen and two girls' hostels. This initiative converts organic waste into nutrient-rich compost, reducing landfill waste and providing natural fertilizer for the college's gardens



# Management of Non-Biodegradable Waste

Non-biodegradable waste is handed over to the Municipal Corporation under the Door-to-Door Garbage Collection Scheme. Single-use plastics—such as bottles and packaging—are collected separately and sold to the Municipal Corporation for recycling. A MoU with the Municipal Corporation, Shimla, further strengthens these efforts while also serving as an additional income source.



### **Single-Use Plastic Collection**

**In an effort to combat plastic pollution, the department launched a campus-wide and community-based drive to collect single-use plastic. Plastic waste is collected from students, staff, and localities, then handed over to the Municipal Corporation (MC) Shimla for proper disposal at a rate of ₹75 per kg. So far, over 100 kg of plastic waste has been collected, earning the college more than ₹7,000 while reducing environmental pollution.**

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered at Mumbai on this 30th day of the month of March 2024 (Two Thousand and Twenty Four) amongst:

**Milk Bag Project**, an initiative by Hansa Pardiwala, Kunti Oza and Chitra Hiromath of Mumbai, having their collection centre at Nathalal Park Marg, Mumbai - 400001, represented by Hansa Pardiwala, their in after referred to as **MBP** (which expression will, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors-in-title and assigns of the **One Part**,

And

Environment Science Club under the patron ship of the Principal RKMV, Shimla and having their address at Environment Science Club, Principal Rajiya Kanya Mahavidyalaya (RKMV) Shimla, H.P, Pin Code 171001, there in after referred to as **RKMV** (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include their executors, administrators, legal representatives and permitted assigns) of the **Other Part**,

**MBP** and **RKMV** are thereafter jointly referred to as **Parties** and individually referred to as a **Party** unless the context requires otherwise.

WITHEREAS:

(A) **MBP** is a public interest initiative jointly by Hansa Pardiwala (associated with "Har Ghar, Har Ghar", Kunti Oza (chairperson of "Clean Mumbai Foundation") and Chitra Hiromath (associated with "Garbage Free India") in Mumbai City.

(B) The Parties are desirous of extending the benefits generally to the public and society for the collection of milk bags in the city of Shimla and have agreed to collaborate on the terms and conditions stated in this MOU.

THE PARTIES THERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Purpose of the Collaboration

- 1.1. **MBP** and **RKMV** have a common objective of generally contributing to the preservation and protection of the environment. In furtherance of their common objective, **RKMV** desires to implement the model as implemented in Mumbai by **MBP**.

- 1.2. **RKMV** has agreed to collect **Milk Bags** from residents / establishments in and around the college & to use its premises as a collection point for people who wish to send their clean and dry milk packets at their own cost. **RKMV** has undertaken to keep a true and accurate inventory of the milk bags.

- 1.3. **MBP** will assist **RKMV** with creating awareness about the initiative and provide leads for residents / establishments from which milk packets are to be collected.

2. Specific role, responsibilities and obligations of **MBP**

- 2.1. **MBP** will provide **RKMV** leads of its associates in Shimla and generally assist **RKMV** in the implementation of the initiative in Shimla.

- 2.2. **MBP** will provide **RKMV** with the necessary knowhow and templated marketing collateral created or requisitioned by them along with broad guidelines for the association of the project in Shimla.

- 2.3. **MBP** will connect **RKMV** to people in Shimla for the collection of milk bags.

- 2.4. **MBP** will connect **RKMV** to their collection partner in Delhi since that is the closest collection point. However, **RKMV** will be at liberty to find a recycling partner on their own.

- 2.5. **MBP** will approve all the marketing materials, publications and any other such public statements made by **RKMV** that may reflect on the association between the Parties.

- 2.6. **MBP** will not be liable to reimburse **RKMV** for any expenses that may be incurred by them while performing their role under this MOU.

- 2.7. **RKMV** will not be liable to bear any expenses in the partnership except for the freight charges of the milk packets.

3. Specific role, responsibilities and obligations of **RKMV**

- 3.1. **RKMV** will collect the milk bags, from the residents / establishments in and around college or will act as a collection center for people who wish to send their clean and dry milk packets at their own cost.

- 3.2. **RKMV** will keep a true and accurate record of the milk bags, collected by them and provide **MBP** an account of the number and weight of the milk bags collected.

- 3.3. **RKMV** will not make any representations or provide any warranties on behalf of **MBP** or any of its members, associates, employees, officers, etc., without their prior express written approval.

- 3.4. **RKMV** is not entitled to bind **MBP** to any contract with a third party whatsoever. Any publication of association between the two parties must be pursuant only to a prior written and express approval by **MBP**.

- 3.5. **RKMV** will not do or omit to do anything which may create disrepute for **MBP** or any of its members, associates, employees, officers, etc.


4. Termination

- 4.1. Either Party may terminate this MOU if the other fails to fulfill their roles and obligations under this MOU. This will be done only after the non-terminating or defaulting Party is provided an opportunity to remedy such failure within a period of 15 days from the intimation to remedy.

- 4.2. Either Party may terminate this MOU by giving the other a notice of termination of not less than 30 days. If this MOU is terminated by **RKMV** for convenience **RKMV** must return to **MBP** any marketing materials remaining with **RKMV**.

- 4.3. Being a government organization **RKMV** has the right to terminate the contract at any stage for whatsoever the reason may be.

- 4.4. Upon termination of this MOU, the Parties may inform various stakeholders of the termination of the association between **RKMV** and **MBP**.






